- Cloud Exponence: multi-cloud management platform supporting AWS, Azure, GCP, or hybrid model, with automated provisioning and orchestration. In addition, digitized application architecture library, cloud economics, and service catalog managed services
- TCS Cloud Modernization service: is designed as an integrated Microservice/ API development factory driven model. The Factory model accelerates and monitors the software construction through its complete lifecycle of build, test, continuous integration and deployment on a cloud platform
- Cloud Pinnacle (Platform) Services: TCS' Cloud Platform services enable enterprises to build their own data platforms with services such as Data Lake PaaS, Data Migration and Data Analytics.
